

Post Operative Instructions

RPC, WaterLase, Frenectomy, Biopsy, and/or Simple Extraction Procedures

Please refrain from eating or drinking until anesthesia has worn off completely.

- 1. You may feel slightly tired after the procedure. Have time available to rest if needed.
- 2. You may take Ibuprofen (Advil) or acetaminophen (Tylenol) for discomfort as long as there is no contraindication with other medications or allergies.
- 3. GENTLE Warm salt water rinses for 2 to 3 days. Add 1 teaspoon table salt to 8 oz. of warm water.
- 4. You may see a tint of blood in your saliva following treatment. This is normal.
- 5. Do not use toothpastes containing tartar control, baking soda and peroxide, or whitening agents.
- 6. You may resume your normal diet however, please avoid the following: Popcorn, peanuts, or foods containing small seeds (such as sesame, poppy, etc.) for 48-72 hours.
